WALLINGFORD, CT- The running attack is headlined by Anthony Avery, Eric Brown and recently aquired John Chisholm. Avery's durability proved valuable last season being the team's only running back to carry the ball in every game. Eric Alicia and NEFL All-Star Paul Catalo will control the offensive line which averages size of 6'3 280 pounds.

"We feel great about our offensive weapons this year" said quarterback Rich Snowden, "we're all healthy and have a good understanding of our playbook". The Bearcats signal caller will begin the season as the team starter and showed last year that he's one of the league's top playmakers with 17 total touchdowns.

The Bearcats receivers may be the among the best we see all season . All Stars Jason Davis and Naciki Reid provide a great one-two punch. The 6'3 Kevin Taylor and 6'2 Chris Blackwell are big targets that creates mismatches to most cornerbacks. "When we come out in our four receiver sets we are tough" said Snowden.
